Animated GIFs: A Trick or Treat The animated GIF file format was introduced in 1987 by CompuServe and used to store animated video clip data until 1998 when Apple invented and championed the use of MP4 instead. The GIF's popularity grew thanks to the image viewer software Gopher, which could download multiple files as a portion of a multipart file, and the GIF was officially adopted as a file format on May 17, 1992. The GIF was offered as an open, royalty free file format on November 8, 1993, becoming the first animated format to achieve common web use. The GIF has been used on the web since 1996 but is a target for all sorts of malicious attacks. The GIF file format is primarily used to store bitmaps that are basically black and white, monochrome, or grayscale images with no animation or transparency. It's still widely used and acceptable in almost all web design, as opposed to, say, a Flash animation, which is more commonly used in web development. But GIF images are notoriously a target for attackers. They're resource-intensive, single-track files that require significant bandwidth. They're typically known to present themselves as generic icons (e.g. smiling faces, banners, eagles, stars, etc.) that can be recognizable and distract users from malicious attacks. It can take many networks seconds to download an animated GIF, which makes it a welcome tool for various phishing attacks, since most people clicking on a link will wait for the download before doing anything else. Users have reported cases of being tricked by reels of pirated movies and several adult websites using GIF files to disguise their attacks. The GIF specification includes methods for compression, manipulation, transparency, animation, and several other useful functionality, but it's common for GIF images to be compressed with H.261 or H.263 encoders, which degrades the image quality. The compression methods employed by most older browsers ensure that today, gif files aren't playable without a special plugin. Gif Bomb is a simple and effective exploit developed by Jeremiah Grossman for a lucky website. A GIF file is basically a whole series of frames that are ordered and stored. The browser requests the first frame as soon as the GIF file is downloaded and parsed by the web server. Gif Bomb provides a way for people to make a dynamic GIF that appears to be active, but is in fact a
